#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

After conducting a successful June General Meeting along comes COVID again and makes a mess of things. July was an online Zoom meeting however we only got 16 members attending which was a bit disappointing.

The main discussion point at the June meeting was the current Department of Transport review of the Club Permit Scheme (CPS). It was difficult wading through the various documents prior to the meeting to get an understanding of what was proposed. In the documents I read it did indicate that there were to be increases in the Permit fees for both 45 days and 90 days. Fortunately Brian Crocker had read them a little closer and corrected me on this matter, as I had used an earlier document rather than the final version. At this time there is no fee increase proposed. Time will tell of course as one never knows what will come out of reviews so let's hope that is the case.

The main changes that will interest us is a change from the current 25 year eligibility to 30 years, tightening up of the documentation required for CPS applications, new penalties for misuse of the logbooks and better definition of what is a Replica.

After the meeting Bill Redpath gave us an excellent presentation on the Variety Bash and his EH Holden bash vehicle he had on display in the foyer. Bill has completed 31 variety bashes which must be some type of record. On many of these bashes he has been accompanied by his wife Heather. This car did its first bash in 1991 and has had an amazing career since then, including a roll over and full rebuild.

Barry Smith has organised a CHACA Annual Tour in September as a combined event with the Veteran, Vintage & Classic Vehicle Club of Wangaratta. They are holding their Spring Rally over the period 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> September. This rally is centred in Wangaratta and includes a Silo Tour and other interesting sites. Come along and join this event as it should be a great weekend. Contact Barry Smith if you wish to join in. Details elsewhere in the Journal.



Because of systems limitations they are <u>only</u> available for order online for permit holders who have a myVicRoads account. Replacement and slimline club permit plates cannot be ordered at VicRoads' Customer Service Centres (CSC). Slimline club permit plates are only available for new issue club permits at CSCs.

Currently, only H or CH plates are available in the slimline format. M plates and SR plates will be available shortly and we will be advised when they are available.





#### CHACA CLUB PERMIT SCHEME **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

CHACA is a VicRoads authorised Club to participate in the VicRoads Club Permit Scheme (CPS).

VicRoads has set rules to determine the eligibility of vehicles for the Club Permit Scheme. These may be viewed in the CPS handbook or on the VicRoads website. CHACA has set its own additional requirements for vehicles to be submitted for the CPS using CHACA's authorisation. The additional requirements are in line with the original CHACA charter of vehicle originality and preservation.

The following are CHACA's requirements for Members submitting vehicles for CPS assessment.

- 1. The vehicle must have been manufactured prior to 1st December 1992.
- 2. The member submitting the application must have been a CHACA member for at least 3 months.
- 3. Vehicles submitted for CPS application must be as the manufacturer originally designed and built. Some modifications are permitted in line with the original manufacture option list, are period correct, or are based on safety issues, but in all cases must not detract from originality. Replicas derived from a lower model are acceptable as long as the appearance is as original as possible to the intended vehicle model (e.g. GT Falcon from a base Falcon).
- 4. Applicants for the CPS will certify that the vehicle submitted will remain roadworthy during the permit period and unmodified from what was originally submitted.
- Once a vehicle has been accepted by CHACA for CPS it will be the members' responsibility to 5. maintain the vehicle as originally presented, with no further modifications and in a roadworthy condition for all permit renewal applications.
- Determination of the eligibility for any vehicle submitted to CHACA for CPS will be at the discre-6. tion of the Committee. Vehicle CPS application must be submitted to the Technical Officer in writing.





